Funding Available for Managed Detection and Response

The MassCyberCenter is providing grants under the Cyber Resilient Massachusetts Grant Program to **municipalities**, **small businesses**, and **non-profits** in Massachusetts to fund *Managed Detection and Response* (MDR) services from [CyberTrust Massachusetts](#). Grants provide up to \$25,000 to fund MDR for up to 3 years.

The CyberTrust Massachusetts Security Operations Center provides MDR with the support of [SentinelOne](#). This service positions organizations to detect and respond to cybersecurity threats and includes the following:

- Managed 24x7 endpoint detection and response
- Network Discovery
- Vulnerability Assessment
